To ensure player safety, Babe Ruth has partnered with Sports Engine to provide **industry leading background screenings**, and **abuse prevention training**.

How will the registration process change?

If you're an online registration customer, your registrants will need to first register as a manager/coach with your league. Then, they will follow the link from their receipts to proceed to the background check. *They will not automatically be taken to the background check after registration.* Here is the link for your reference: <https://baberuthsafety.sportngin.com/register/form/277089265>

How will I know if my volunteer is compliant?

Before submitting your rosters, you will need to make sure that your volunteers have completed their background check and safety training.

To do this, you will need to choose your region from [this list](#). From there, you'll see a list of names that you can check against. You can also export the report if desired.

What information can I provide to my volunteers for assistance?

You can distribute this [Coach Eligibility Checklist](#) to any potential managers/coaches you wish to roster for the 2019 season. This checklist provides step by step instruction of this new process, provides access to further information regarding questions that might arise, and will direct volunteers to the proper contact channels if additional assistance is required.
